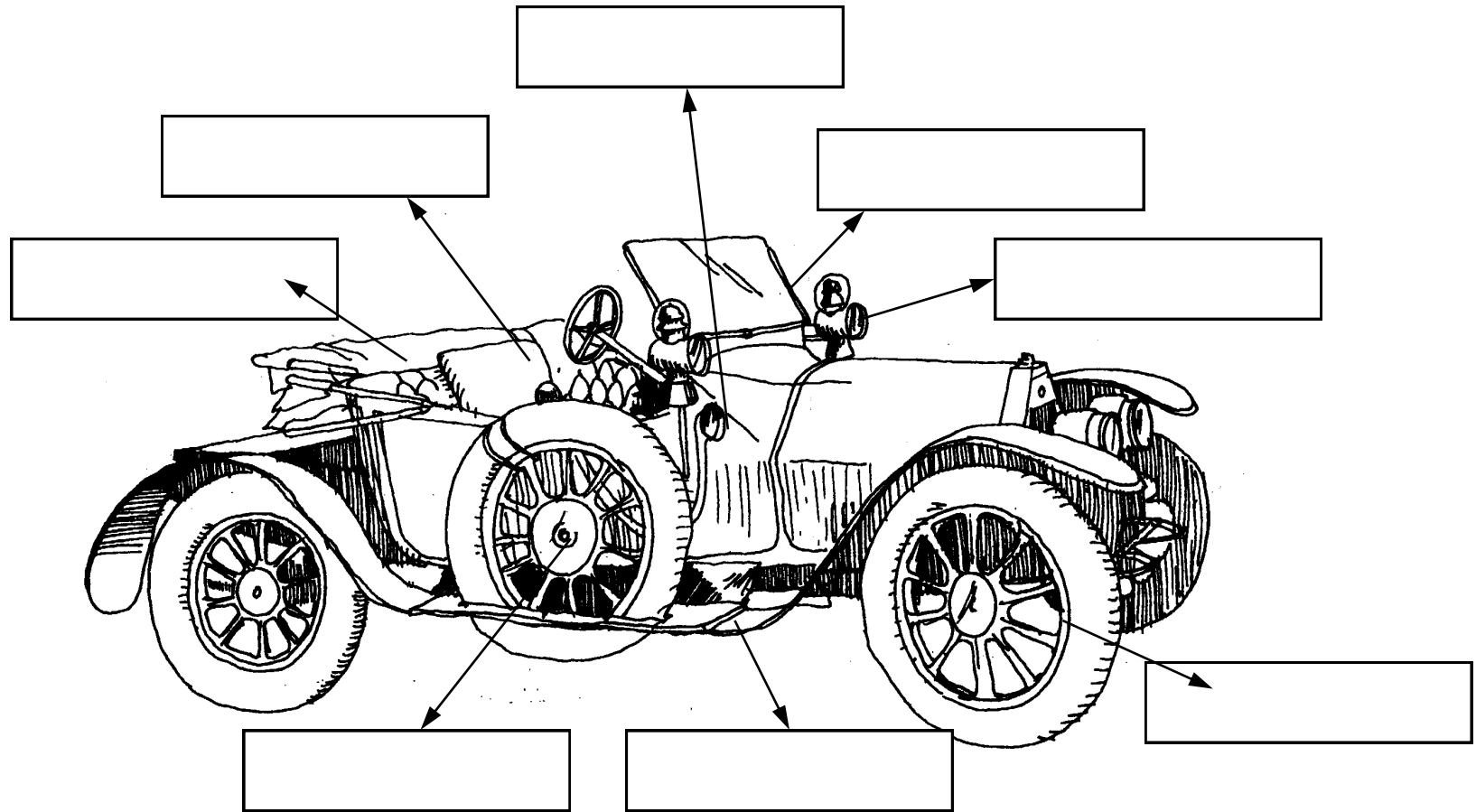

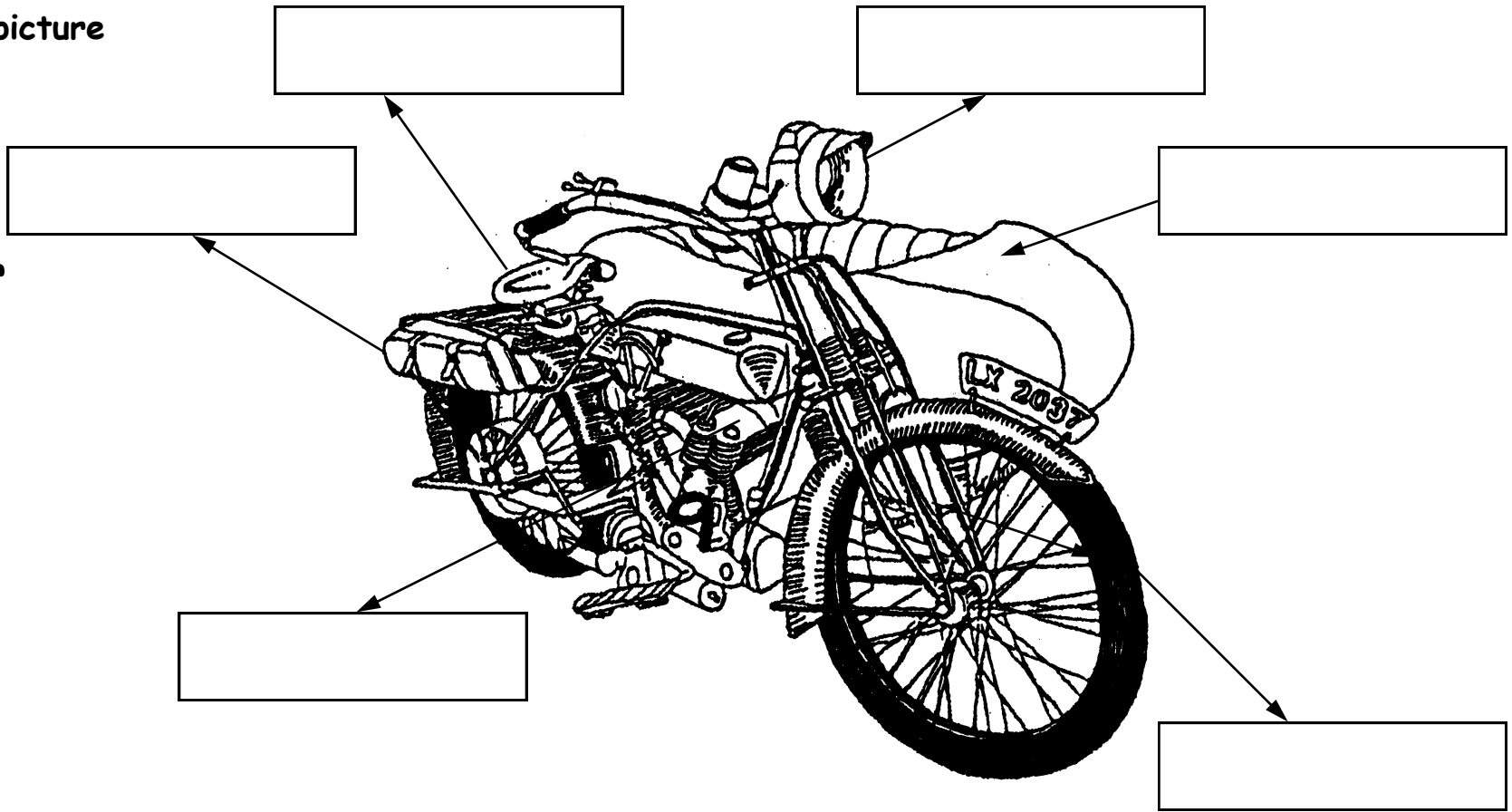

Activity Sheet Notes for Teachers

Suggestions for using these sheets

These activity sheets are intended to be used to follow up on a visit to the road transport collection in the Air and Space Hall. More information is available in *Road Transport in the Air and Space Hall: Self -Guided Notes for KS1 Teachers* available on the Museum's website.

The two vehicle pictured are:

- Belsize motor car 1912
- Royal Ruby motor cycle and sidecar, 1916

The children label the two pictures. They could do the same beforehand with a picture of a modern vehicle.

The objective in using these sheets could be that the children will recognise features of road transport from the past.

Additional activities could be devised by using the images of the vehicles to:

- write an information text in the form of a museum display panel about the vehicle,
- list similarities and differences between the vehicles.
